## 1. Release Overview

Bonzai version 2.2.1 release is a point release that fixes a few issues and provides an additional improvement to caching in Bonzai.

## 2. Summary of Issues Fixed

#### 2.1 Issues Fixed in v2.2.1

Detailed below are the fixes in this release:

- Fixed an issue where the site settings were not being loaded when Sharepoint is configured to use a non-supported Bonzai language. (BOINT-8716).
  - The site settings API call was trying to retrieve the configuration for the Bonzai by passing a non-existent locale code. This release fixes that by falling back to EN if the active Sharepoint language is not among the ones that Bonzai currently supports.
- Fixed an issue with custom date fields in People Listing Web Part (BOINT-9130).
  - The date properties in People Listing items were being rendered relative to the viewer's timezone, which may or may not be the same as the item creator's timezone. This fixes that by ensuring that no timezone offset is applied to the date when being rendered, thereby always displaying the same date as intended.
- Fixed an issue that caused the News Rollup to display inconsistent behaviour when another web part is using a source having the same List and View names, even from a different subsite. (BOINT-10305)
  - This was because of the new caching behaviour of Bonzai, that stores basic information about the List and View combinations used in web parts. Because it was using a combination of List and View names as the cache key, it lacked the necessary level of uniqueness. This release fixes that by introducing a third element - the source url - to the cache key, making the key truly unique, and resolving the inconsistent behaviour for web parts.



- Fixed an issue where publishing an already existing Bonzai Event Page, even without changes, would create a new duplicate Event Calendar entry. (BOINT-11253)
  - This is related to an issue fixed in the 2.2.0 release, where comments were not getting retrieved by the API query, because a certain type of condition that was being used in both queries to retrieve comments, and existing calendar entries, suddenly stopped working (presumably due to a Microsoft update to Sharepoint). This release fixes the event calendar duplication issue in the same method as the comment fix in 2.2.0.

# 3. Known Issues

• Known Issues identified in the 2.2.0 release notes, that are not included in the Fixed Issues list, still exist, and are either scheduled for an upcoming release, or actively being resolved.

# 4. System Requirements

Required software is noted below, with an emphasis on the following terms:

- Certified this release was tested specifically against this configuration.
- **Supported** this release was not tested against this specific configuration, though it remains supported as differences between it and the certified software are minimal or not applicable to Bonzai.
