1. Release Overview

Bonzai version 2.1.3 release delivers multiple improvements to Bonzai headers across multiple sections, in addition to providing better compatibility for navigation terms. It also simplifies some pages in Brick to provide a smoother user experience.

2. What's New in this Release

2.1 Improvements to Brick

For 2.1.3, Brick now loads all users available to the logged-in admin in the user list, making them all accessible through search at the same time. We've also removed the "enabled" column, providing wider breathing room for the other columns in the list.

2.2 Reponsive Header Images

Bonzai header images are now made responsive. The header images for News, Events, and other associated Page Layouts now adapt much better to different screen sizes and will no longer distort.

3. Summary of Issues Fixed

3.1 Issues Fixed in v2.1.3

Detailed below are the fixes in this release:

- Improved cache durability of the Stocks API to 2 hours (from 5 minutes), while still maintaining the 5-minute freshness of stocks data. This means that the Stocks API will remain operational for up to two hours during AlphaVantage maintenance windows and outages. (BOINT-7447)
- Removed the "Enabled" yes/no column from Brick's User List screen, since it would always display
 "Yes" as a value. (BOINT-7442)



- Fixed an issue where a network slow-down would prevent comments from being posted. (BOINT-7381)
- Properties of navigation terms are no longer case-sensitive (newWindow is now treated the same as NewWindow) when creating menu and header links. (BOINT-7294)
- Fixed a rendering issue with "promoted" item icons in the Event Rollup webpart configured to display as event tiles. (BOINT-7273)
- Logo images no longer overflow into the menu when they are wider than the defined width in Brick.
 (BOINT-7270)
- Removed an extra validation message when clearing the Border Radius and Logo Width values in Brick to replace with different values. (BOINT-7219)
- Text overlays on top of Landing Items in the Landing webpart now wrap properly in Internet Explorer. (BOINT-7203)
- Selecting the French authoring language now renders all menu items to French. (BOINT-7128)
- Updated the Image Rendition dimensions for "Bonzai Landing Image Three Column" to match the aspect ratio of the other renditions. (BOINT-7060)
- Hyperlinks in the Important Messages webpart now appear the same color as the rest of the message. (BOINT-7025)
- Fixed a long-standing issue with the Landing Webpart rendition when placed inside a Tabbed Webpart (BOINT-7019)
- Now loading all users that are available to the current Brick admin, removing the necessity for a "Load More" button. (BOINT-7007)
- Fixed the German translations for some words in the Event Page. (BOINT-7003)
- Hero images are now responsive and maintain their aspect ratio when displayed in different screen sizes. They no longer appear distorted in some screens. (BOINT-6861, BOINT-6849)
- Removed references and API calls to New Relic. (BOINT-7528)
- Fixed an issue where disabling the pagination in a webpart sets a row limit of 10 items regardless of the item display limit from within the source view settings. (BOINT-7505, BOINT-7534)

4. Known Issues

• Although we are now setting a 24-hour cache expiration for the javascript in CDN, some browsers may take a couple of tries before it replaces its cached **bonzai.min.js** and **bonzai.styles.min.css**



with fresh copies from CDN. If this happens, you have the following cache-busting options to refresh your cache immediately:

- 1. Open the link to bonzai.min.js in a new tab. Hit ctrl+f5 to force a refresh of the file.
- 2. Open the link to your theme (after republishing) and perform the same force refresh.
- 3. You should now have the latest version of the JS and CSS files.

5. Compatible Software

This release is compatible with the following software:

- Microsoft SharePoint 2013 with Service Pack 1 or higher, Microsoft SharePoint 2016, SharePoint Online
- Microsoft SQL Standard and Enterprise note that this release of Bonzai supports the version of Microsoft SQL that SharePoint supports (SP2013 | SP2016)
- Web Browsers: Although Bonzai works on most modern browsers, Bonzai officially supports the following (and we are working hard to certify and add more to the list):
 - 1. Internet Explorer 11
 - 2. Latest Version 71.0.3578.98 of Chrome (desktop + mobile).
 - 3. Latest Version of Safari (mobile)
- Brick currently supports Chrome.

6. How to Install or Upgrade to this Release

As 2.1.3 is a point update, and no SharePoint components were directly impacted, there will be no backend deployment necessary for this upgrade.

The following steps will be executed by the Bonzai Team, and require no action from the customer:

- 1. Deploy the CDN components from the Bonzai Deployment Package.
- 2. Deploy Brick using the Bonzai Deployment Package.

The following minor steps can be performed by the customer in SharePoint to synchronize some elements with the update:



- 1. Log on to Brick and republish the site's theme to update to the latest CSS changes.
- 2. Update the Image Rendition dimensions for "Bonzai Landing Image Three Column" to 436x249.
