1. Release Overview

Bonzai version 2.1.5 delivers important updates to prevent and fix issues triggered by Microsoft's latest update to the Office 365 Navigation Bar.

2. Summary of Issues Fixed

2.1 Issues Fixed in v2.1.5

Detailed below are the fixes in this release:

- Fixed an error in bonzai.min.js triggered by the Microsoft patch that is cascading to cause multiple issues such as webpart custom configurations not appearing when editing, section shading in page layouts not getting applied, as well as the content search web part not rendering results. (BOINT-8178)
- Fixed an issue where the Bonzai pages would no longer show the Bonzai Custom Tabs (Target Options, Page Options) when in edit mode. (BOINT-8198)
- Fixed an issue where hitting Enter/Return to submit a query inside a search page (Document Center, News, Events, etc.) would cause the page to refresh and lose the search terms entered. (BOINT-8195)
- Fixed an issue where the tabs for the tabbed web part were wrapping to the next line prematurely in small zones and screen widths. (BOINT-8177)

3. Known Issues

- Although we are now setting a 24-hour cache expiration for the JavaScript in CDN, some browsers may require a couple of tries before it replaces its cached bonzai.min.js and bonzai.styles.min.css with fresh copies from CDN. If this happens, you have the following cachebusting options to refresh your cache immediately:
- Open the link to bonzai.min.js in a new tab. Hit ctrl+f5 to force a refresh of the file.



4. Compatible Software

This release is compatible with the following software:

- Microsoft SharePoint 2013 with Service Pack 1 or higher, Microsoft SharePoint 2016, SharePoint Online
- Microsoft SQL Standard and Enterprise note that this release of Bonzai supports the version of Microsoft SQL that SharePoint supports (SP2013 | SP2016)
- Web Browsers: Although Bonzai works on most modern browsers, Bonzai officially supports the following (and we are working hard to certify and add more to the list):
 - 1. Internet Explorer 11
 - 2. Latest Version 72.0.3626.121 of Chrome (desktop + mobile).
 - 3. Latest Version of Safari (mobile)
- Brick currently supports Chrome.

5. How to Install or Upgrade to this Release

Release 2.1.5 updates both the Bonzai JavaScript library in the CDN, as well as all the Page Layouts. As a result, it needs additional action to be taken inside SharePoint to update and publish the new Page Layout Versions. There is no Brick update in this release.

The following steps will be executed by the Bonzai Team:

1. Deploy the CDN components from the Bonzai Deployment Package.

The action below can be executed by Office 365 customers by following the steps provided. This is an optional step for On-Prem customers, as they are not affected by the Microsoft Patch. However, **this is a critical step for Office 365 customers**, and will ensure compatibility with the latest Microsoft patch.

- 1. If the Office 365 customer is in version 2.0 or older, the only way to make their Bonzai compatible with the new Microsoft Patch is to upgrade to 2.1.5. To do this, the customer needs to open a ticket with support to request the upgrade.
- 2. If the Office 365 customer is on version 2.1 they can either upload and publish these new page layouts to their SharePoint environment themselves before April 6th, or they can open a ticket and Support will upload on their behalf. This will allow Bonzai to be compatible with the new Microsoft Patch once version 2.1.5 of Bonzai is deployed.
 - a. Download the new page layouts from the link provided.



- b. Log in to SharePoint and open the site settings.
- c. Open the Master Pages and Page Layouts administration page and drill down into the Bonzai folder inside it.
- d. Upload the new page layouts that were downloaded.
- e. Publish new major versions for each of the page layouts.

Although updating the page layouts can happen before, during, or after the 2.1.5 release, until the new page layouts are uploaded and published in SharePoint, the customer will continue to experience the issues related to it.
